# EDUCATOR RESIDENCY PROGRAM AT KIPP NC TEACHER U

The Educator Residency Program is an accelerated
13-month program designed to prepare current KIPP North
Carolina teachers in meeting NC DPI licensure
requirements.



- K-6 Elem., K-12 SPED, or 5-8 MS ELA Licensure
- 2-4 courses per semester (non-credit bearing)
- Asynchronous (virtual) coursework
- Weekly Live Class Nights

- Cohort model
- Personalized coaching
- Mentor Teachers for individualized support
- Routine coaching and observations



Candidates must fulfill all requirements set forth by North Carolina Department of Public Instruction (NCDPI). This includes yearly licensure renewal, active employment, testing, coursework, professional learning, etc.

Enrollment in KIPP NC Teacher U program does not guarantee employment or fulfillment of all licensure requirements. Always consult with NC DPI & KIPP NC Teacher U websites regarding processes and deadlines.

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

#### Applicants to KIPP NC Teacher U must meet the following requirements:

An official, degree-conferred UG transcript with proof of a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution of higher education or equivalent earned at a recognized foreign institution.

A minimum of a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.7 on 4.0 scale\*.

A belief that ALL children can go to college, succeed in any career, and conquer any goal they decide to pursue 24 credit hours of coursework in the requested licensure area OR passing scores on Pearson Foundations of Reading/Math, Praxis Math (7813) or the required exams for the content area.\*

Hired for a full-time classroom position at KIPP NC school.

Demonstrated work ethic, followthrough on challenging tasks, and the discipline to prioritize, execute, and communicate early and often.

\*Applicants with a GPA below 2.7 who have at least 5 years of relevant experience may be admitted to KIPP NC Teacher U.













# PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Candidates must meet the following criteria upon program completion:

- Completion of the required course of study with a 70% (or a C-) in all courses AND a minimum 2.7 GPA;
- Completion of 12 hours of Field experiences during their Residency
  Year (e.g., small group instruction, community engagement, classroom observations)
- Satisfactory completion of clinical Residency of at least one (1) academic year;
- Attempt all NC State Board of Education required content area exam(s) for the requested licensure area; and a passing edTPA assessment score.
- 3-year employee commitment with KIPP North Carolina
